THE HALT-PROJECT: 2009-2011

<u>HALT</u> = Healthcare Associated infections in Long-Term care facilities (LTCF)





What? In a network of LTCFs in Europe:

- •Study and describe:
- Healthcare associated infections (HAI),
- Antimicrobial use (AB),
- Antimicrobial resistance (AMR)
- Explore risk factors for infection on resident and facility level
- •Identify current resources: infection prevention policy, antimicrobial stewardship

How? based on IPSE & ESAC-NH project

- •Point Prevalence Survey (PPS): 1 day, pilot: 11/'09 EU-wide: 05-09/'10
- •LTCFs: nursing homes, residential, rehabilitation, psychiatric, mental,....
- •Residents: stay permanently, present at 8 am, since min. 24 h.


with systemic AB and/or with signs or symptoms of
