



Ex-ante publicity notice in negotiated procurement procedure

“Guidance on Strategic Planning for Public Health Emergency Preparedness”, NP/2016/PHC/5635/01

Short description

European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) has the mission to identify, assess and communicate current and emerging threats to human health from communicable diseases. Article 9.1 of the ECDC mandate notes that it shall provide scientific and technical expertise in the development, regular review and updating of preparedness plans.¹ In this project, the successful candidate will produce a document for ECDC entitled: Guidance on Strategic Planning for Public Health Emergency Preparedness. The purpose of this guidance document would be to provide Member States and public health planners a systematic approach for planning public health preparedness activities.

The principle area of expertise related to this project include public health emergency preparedness, strategic planning in public health, and communicable disease prevention and control.

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procurement procedure 60,000 Euros with a minimum of 3 candidates, through which ECDC may award the above-mentioned contract.

All economic operators interested in providing the services described above should express their interest before **17/06/2016**, 16h00 CET, by e-mail to **tenders@ecdc.europa.eu** with the same subject reference as indicated above.

This information will be taken into account by ECDC in order to identify potential candidates.
