Ex-ante publicity notice in negotiated procurement procedure

Subject: "ECDC Official Car" NP/2016/DIR/5651/01

Short description

The objective of this tender is to purchase a new official (diplomatic) car to ECDC.

Minimum requirements

1. General:

1. Mid-sized executive class car with saloon/sedan body/4 doors

2. Safety features:

1. All-wheel drive (AWD) or comparable system
2. Automatic transmission gearbox
3. Side impact head protection curtains in both front and back seats
4. Fog lights in both front and rear
5. Remote controlled central locking system with burglar alarm
6. Additional powerful revers lights integrated or placed underneath the rear bumper
7. Both summer tires and winter tires (not studded)
8. Laminated windows

3. Other

1. Fully integrated updateable GPS navigation system with traffic information system or comparable
2. Drive computer or a comparable vehicle information system
3. Leather upholstery
4. Sun curtains on the rear door windows and the rear window
5. Metallic paint
6. Display language in all vehicle system: English
7. Sound system with Bluetooth system
8. First aid kit
9. Fire-extinguishers

ECDC expects the candidate to take over the current vehicle at the time of the delivery of the new vehicle.

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procurement procedure below 60,000 with a minimum of 3 candidates, through which ECDC may award the above-mentioned contract.
