2. The purpose of the processing is to...

Manage and handle external access requests for data contained in the European Surveillance System (TESSy) for research purposes/tasks in the public interest that include validation of the identity of the data requester, the declaration of commitment and the declaration of data destruction.

3. The categories of data collected and used for the processing operations are...

Data subject details:

- first name and surname;
- telephone number;
- email address;
- place/location when/where signing;
- affiliation with a particular organization (name, address, country).

Personal information contained in any emails exchanged between the data subject and ECDC personnel related to the TESSy data access request.

4. The recipients of the data are...

Recipients include internal ECDC personnel, designated representative/s of the data providers' institutions, EU bodies and EU and national courts where required by law.

5. The legal basis of the processing operation at stake is...

- Article 11(2) of ECDC Founding Regulation (EC) 851/2004
- Decision No 1082/2013/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2013 on serious cross-border threats to health and repealing Decision No 2119/98/EC
- Regulation 1049/2001 regarding public access to EU documents
- Policy on data submission, access, and use of data within TESSy

6. Data will be retained...

For 10 years after the closure of the request.

Please be aware that data subjects have the right to access and rectify information concerning them stored by ECDC. Data subjects can have their data erased if the processing is unlawful.
